Which artworks caught your eye most? Why so? Let's think about why.

4 **Let's share what you have seen and thought to everyone!**

What sort of stories can you come up with from the artworks?
Let's share what you have seen and discovered to your friends and guardians!

5 **Let's make artworks by yourself!**

Once you are at home, let's use your imagination freely and draw what you have seen and felt today. What sort of colours and shapes are you going to use?
Let's make your own artworks!
